

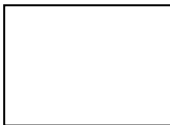
Father Wahl's Garden of Memories

Reverend Raymond Wahl was appointed the first pastor of Sacred Heart Church in October 1956 by the Bishop of Rochester James E. Kearney. Father Wahl served in this capacity until his retirement in 1982. He oversaw the building of the convent, the establishment of the school, the building of the church and the creation of the devotional infrastructure of the parish. He was much loved and admired by all and is responsible for the growth and success of our wonderful parish. He died at the age of 87 in 1999.

To commemorate the 50th anniversary of the parish, and for a parish fundraiser, the 50th Anniversary Committee is sponsoring a brick patio garden in Father's Wahl's memory to honor our loved ones-living and deceased.

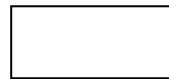
Approximately 225 bricks have been purchased. Now that it is established the garden can be added to at any time. It was dedicated on October 6, 2007.
